



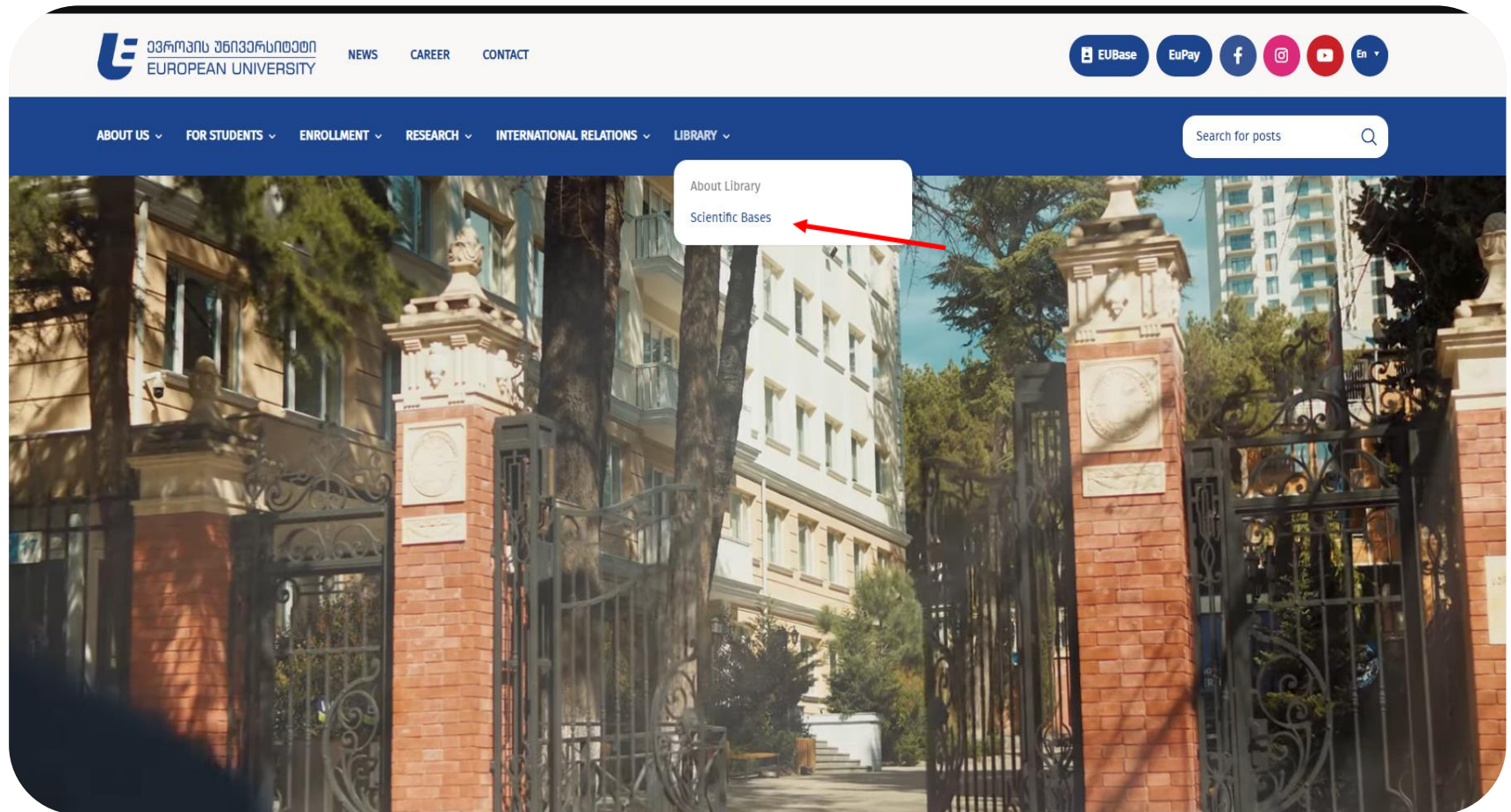

EBSCO databases can be accessed both on university campuses and from other locations.

In case of using from the university building, it is necessary to search for scientific databases in the library section of the university website.



About EBSCO In scientific databases, place the mouse cursor on the word "Follow this link", after which you will be directly at the EBSCO base, in case of access from the campuses.

To access EBSCO EP Package ELITE and legal database HeinOnline [follow this link](#). When entering the link from outside of the university premise you will need identification data - contact the library staff to get a username and password.

To access the database from any other location, EBSCO requires you to identify yourself. For this, you need to enter the identification data in the corresponding field: Contact the library to receive a password.
