




EBSCO databases can be accessed both on university campuses and from other locations.

In case of using from the university building, it is necessary to search for scientific databases in the library section of the university website.



About EBSCO In scientific databases, place the mouse cursor on the word "Follow this link", after which you will be directly at the EBSCO base, in case of access from the campuses.




To access the database from any other location, EBSCO requires you to identify yourself. For this, you need to enter the identification data in the corresponding field: Contact the library to receive a password.



Important User Information: Remote access to EBSCO's databases is permitted to patrons of subscribing institutions accessing from remote locations for personal, non-commercial use. However, remote access to EBSCO's databases from non-subscribing institutions is not allowed if the purpose of the use is for commercial gain through cost reduction or avoidance for a non-subscribing institution.




After opening the home page of the database, if desired, you can drop down and select/highlight the database in which you want to find information on the desired topic.



If you don't know which database may contain information of interest to you, then mark <u>"Select / deselect all"</u> and then press the <u>"Continue"</u> button



A column will appear, where you can write the desired topics, rubric, word and press the search field Information can be opened by articles, full texts and years.




As a result of the search, you will see all the articles suggested by the database, which deal with interesting topics.

They can also be filtered in the right corner of the web page with filters to explore the information, you can sort it according to your needs.



The searched article can be viewed as desired. For example: download and save the PDF version, or read the text online.

Also, according to the working tools on the left side, mark, save, etc.
